

Make Your 2021 Vote Count!

STEP 1: Register to Vote

Are You Registered?

Check to see if you are registered at <u>www.VotesPA.com</u> or by contacting the Allegheny County Office of Elections (see below).

Re-Register if you moved or changed your name since you last voted.

Register if you never voted in PA before.

Who Can Register?

You must be a US Citizen, *and* age18 by **November 2, 2021**, *and* a PA resident for 30 days before the election, *and*

You must have a PA Driver's License or a PennDOT ID or a Social Security Number.

How to Register or Re-Register

Option 1: PAPER Registration

- To obtain a PAPER Registration Form:
 - * Get one, by **phone or in-person**, from the Allegheny County Office of Elections.
 - * Or, download one online at VotesPA.com and print it out.
- Complete the form (in black ink), **sign and date it,** and **mail** it to the Allegheny County Office of Elections (see address below).

Option 2: Apply Online at VotesPA.com

- Must have PA Driver's License or PennDOT ID to submit your application online.
- If you do not have either of these, you can download and print the application form, sign and date it, and mail it to the Allegheny County Office of Elections (see address below). No printer? Obtain PAPER Registration Form, as above.

Register NOW or apply at least 2 weeks before deadline. Your registration application must be received on or before this date. (OVER)

STEP 2: Cast Your Ballot

Option 1: In Person

At your polling place on **November 2, 2021, 7 am to 8 pm.** Contact any of the resources at the bottom of this flyer to find your polling place. It may have changed since you registered.

Option 2: No-excuse, Mail-in Ballot (There are 2 parts to this option.) Any registered voter (see STEP 1) can use a mail-in ballot, no excuse is needed!

✓ First, Apply for a Mail-in Ballot – When Application Process Opens

To get a PAPER Mail-in Ballot Application, either,

- Request one be mailed to you, by phone (see Allegheny County Office of Elections or League of Women Voters below) or
- Download and print one online at <u>www.VotesPA.com</u>.
- On receipt of your paper Mail-In Ballot Application, complete it and return it IMMEDIATELY, as instructed.

To complete an **ONLINE Mail-in Ballot Application,** go to <u>www.VotesPA.com</u>. You must have a PA Driver's License or PennDOT ID to apply online.

Deadline for application: Oct. 26, 5.00 pm. <u>BUT DON'T WAIT!</u> – Do it NOW or apply at least 2 weeks before the deadline. Postmark does NOT count. Must be <u>received</u> by this date. When approved, your Mail-in Ballot will be mailed to you (beginning in late September).

Second, Complete Your Mail-in-Ballot – As Soon As Possible! Return it IMMEDIATELY to the Allegheny County Elections Division as instructed (read carefully), to be received by Nov. 2, 8 pm. REMEMBER to seal the secrecy envelope that goes inside the return envelope and sign and date the outside of the official return envelope.

> Check the status of your Mail-in Ballot at <u>votespa.com/mailballotstatus</u>. "Pending" status means your application is approved and your ballot will be mailed in late Sept.
